Ged Wilson is a one-man groove machine delivering contemporary blues infused with jazz, soul and roots. Armed with just an acoustic guitar, harmonica and a lifetime of stories, he creates stripped-back music that's rhythmically compelling, warm, and full of good vibes.

Well established on the British blues scene, Ged is signed to Bad Monkey Records and supported by Help Musicians. A seasoned performer, he's played clubs and festivals across the UK and internationally, with shows spanning from Chicago to Singapore. His live sets are upbeat and intimate, blending soulful songwriting, foot-stomping grooves and laconic northern humour.

Often described as a "bluesifier" rather than a traditional blues singer, Ged draws from influences as wide-ranging as Lightnin' Hopkins, Miles Davis, Gil Scott-Heron and Bob Dylan, distilling them into a sound that feels rooted yet refreshingly contemporary. His album *Regular Man* is an honest, heartfelt reflection on life's journey, earning critical praise including "*This is music only a full-grown man could make*" (Blues Matters).
